Projects and Fundraisers

Ongoing projects and fundraisers that the Friends group is involved with include:

- Firewood cutting and bundling—this is our largest fundraiser for the group. Each year with the generous hard work of our volunteers we are able to cut and bundle over 1,000 bundles of firewood to sell to the campers at Mirror Lake and Rocky Arbor State Parks. This covers approximately 1/4 of the demand and the rest we purchase from a vendor. We continue to increase our production so we can raise more money for the parks and we could use your help!
- Fire starters—There's no better way to get a bundle of our firewood going then with our fire starters! Save your old candles, wax and egg cartons and drop them off at the office next time you are through. You can also join our volunteers in making fire starters too!
- Dedication Pavers—The Ishnala foot bridge joins the Echo Rock and Ishnala Trails. The aprons of the bridge are made of a beautiful design landscaping pavers. The Friends group sponsors a program for engraving messages on the pavers.
- Timprovements for the Park—Over the past 10 years and into the future, the Friends have worked with the park with the following projects; Playground Equipment, Paint and repair the Amphitheater benches, build and stain firewood sheds at Mirror Lake and Rocky Arbor, prairie restoration, Ishnala Trail development, wildlife mounts in the office at Mirror Lake and much more. We also support the parks through financial donations to enhance park projects such as the Shelter/Pavilion at the Beach and reconstructing the Amphitheater.

Programs and Events

Each year the Friends help provide support for the park's naturalist program by jointly funding the park naturalist position and providing funding to the naturalist program for speakers and supplies.

In the spring of each year we join volunteers all around the world in celebrating *Earth Day* by doing a special project for the park.

We have discovered that daytime is not the only time to enjoy the hiking trails at Mirror Lake. So to experience the night, we sponsor three Candlelight Events; a Halloween Mystery Hike and 2 Winter Ski and Snowshoe Hikes, each year. At these events we also sell food and beverages for fundraising.
